- 2) Take the completed page one and the signed page two to the correct school official so that they may complete page two. Remember a copy of your transcript is requested as part of page two, so plan accordingly.
- 3) Your transcript and pages one and two are to be mailed or emailed to the Scholarship Committee Chairperson as directed in the enclosed application. The deadline for the application is March 15, 2025, so again plan accordingly.
- 4) Page three the "Coach's Evaluation" should be provided to your bowling Coach or Youth Director in enough time for them to complete the requested information and meet the deadline of March 15, 2025.
